
FORD TRANSIT CONNECT VAN

BED PLATFORM

The bed platform puts the bed, drawer storage, kitchen, refrigerator and much of the electrical system into a beautiful birch plywood structure

- 3 oversized drawers, 3 large storage compartments = +20 cuft of storage. Platform approx: 48" x 70" x 15"
- Birch plywood side consoles for cup/book holders (2 count)
- Custom 4" memory foam+ cushions (3 count)
- Custom design+fit insulated window covers with magnetic attachments (6 count)
- Cabin ceiling, walls, floors all insulated with sound/thermal insulation

















AUXILIARY ELECTRICAL SYSTEM

All components are designed for low power use to extend battery charge. System is good for 3-4 days of moderate use if parked, indefinitely if driven a few hours every couple days. Plug-in to a standard house wall socket to recharge quicker.

- 100 Amp-hour ATM Battery
- Built-in battery charger, plugs into a household 110v outlet.
- Inverter + 110v outlet for laptops, etc.
- 30 quart refrigerator (40 12oz cans) a game changer
- 4 USB ports
- 2 12v outlets
- · 4 interior LED task lights
- 7 interior storage LED lights
- 3 exterior "porch" lights, with user adjustable brightness and color—these are way useful around camp at night
























OUTSIDE CARGO, LIVING
